Ambassador Job Description

Definition:

A No Regrets ambassador is a high capacity volunteer who serves as the first point of contact between the ministry and various community organizations (church, school, prison, and marketplace) for the intended purpose of securing them as a conference host site.

Qualifications:

- Love for Jesus, the church and a passion for No Regrets
- Highly relational and approachable
- Able to communicate clearly and concisely
- Action oriented (don't have to know everything before moving forward)
- A healthy competitive spirit

Responsibilities:

- Work up to five hours per week during conference season (August – March) making contact with active and non-active sites (phone, text, email, in-person visits when possible, etc.)
- Identify prospective sites and recruit/retain them to host upcoming NRC
- Attend monthly virtual meeting (weekly in January); optional bi-monthly virtual prayer meeting
- Maintain detailed and accurate communication records with host site accounts
- Answer basic questions about conference and hand off to HSC or specialist when necessary
- Represent Christ & the ministry well (kind, gracious, encouraging, listen, timely response, etc.)
- Use social media platforms to "like, forward and repost" NR information.
- Regularly listen to NR podcasts
- Build relationships with other ambassadors

Desired Outcomes:

- Introduce NRC to prospective host sites in geographical region
- Retain 90% of assigned list of current host sites
- Collectively grow number of host sites (10-15% annually)
- Hand off host site to NR specialist for future products and services
